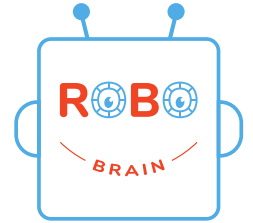


Task 1



- Write a program that turns a string containing a 11 digit telephone number such as "02083461212" into a more readable string with parentheses and a dash, like this: "(020) 8346-1212".
- Part of the program has been written for you. Work out how to define the new number based on the old number.

```
number = "02083461212"  
new_number = ???  
print(new_number)
```



- You may use different number to test your program, e.g.,

`number = "01799003704"` and see whether the resulting new number is `"(017) 9900-3704"`.

Hint: You may use the substring notation to split the number into three parts and insert parentheses and dash to form the new number.
